for the 1st Destination Survey includes outcomes for August and December graduations in the same calendar year and the May graduation of the following calendar year.

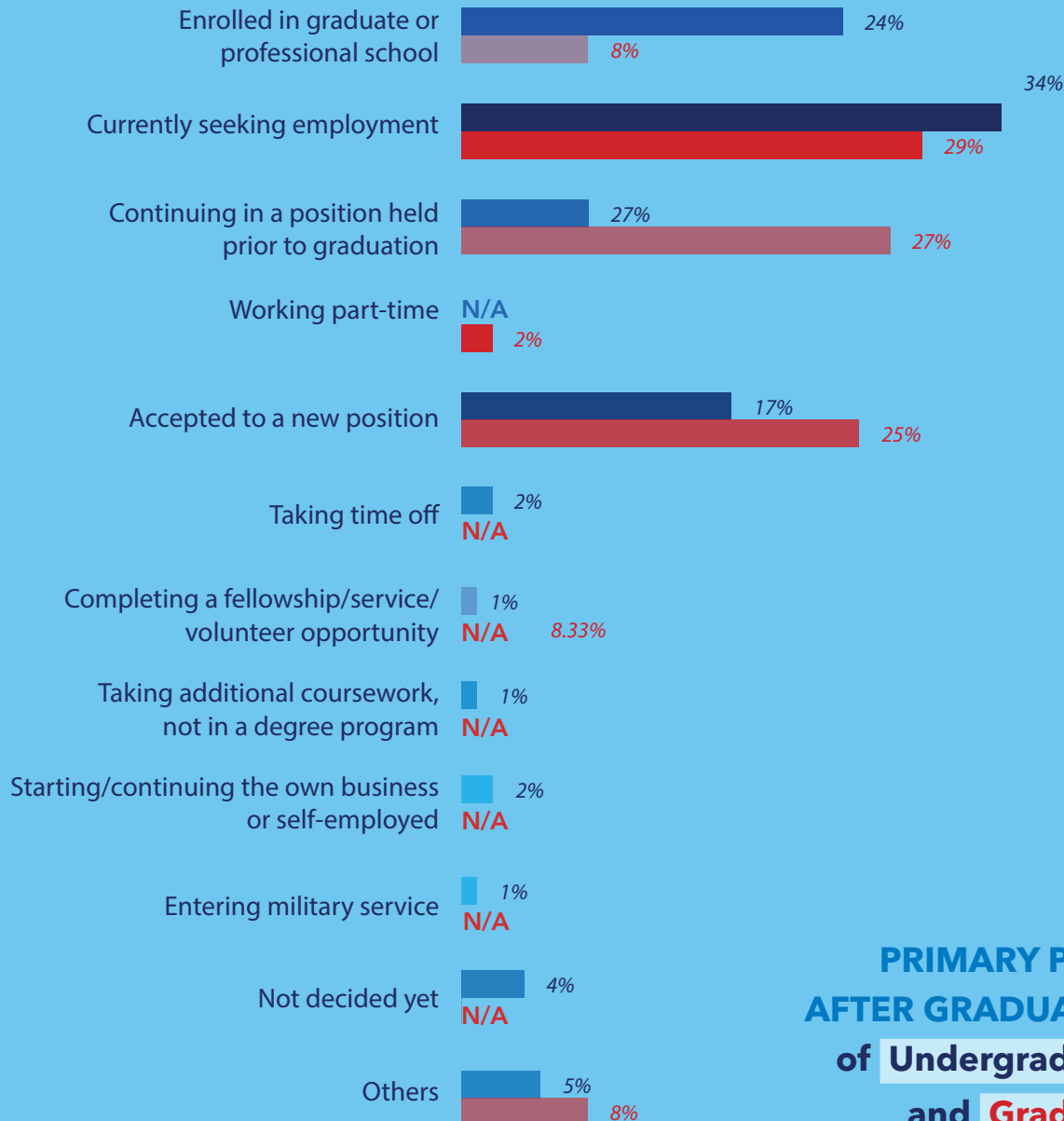
The MTSU Office of Institutional Effectiveness, Planning and Research (IEPR) will begin conducting the 1st Destination Survey for the December 2019 graduating class.
