The proposal is for Graduate Council membership to include three graduate members from each academic cohort, from differing departments. It will still include two graduate students. This proposed cohort model means the Council size will be reduced by six members. Both Dr. Harris and Dr. Handy urged the Council to review the proposed revisions and voice your concerns and comments through the proper channels. A motion was also made for Graduate Council to collectively voice their desire for the current membership format to remain unchanged (3 representatives from each of the academic colleges (with Media and Entertainment combined with University College as one College)). This motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
