I. Collecting Examples of E-Portfolios for Reflection and Integrative Thinking

On February 2, 2015, Jason Vance, Subcommittee Chair, distributed an assignment to Subcommittee members asking them to look for examples of other universities that use e-portfolios for reflective and integrative learning within their broad academic disciplines by February 24. Vance compiled these examples into a document and emailed it to Dr. Rust on March 10, 2015.

II. Evidence of High Impact Engagement Practices at MTSU

On February 20, 2015, Dr. Rust asked the Subcommittee to compile a list of high-impact engagement opportunities that currently exist on MTSU's campus. Vance drafted this document on behalf of the Subcommittee and sent it to Dr. Rust on May 11, 2015.
