

MTSU School of Agribusiness and Agriscience Sophomore, Junior and Senior Scholarships

Applications for scholarships are received during March, evaluated by a group of students and faculty, and recipients are announced at the Agricultural Awards Banquet, normally held mid-April. Monetary awards are available during registration of the following fall semester, and amount of award is dependent upon funds available from endowment. Half of the award amount will be applied to the fall tuition, and the other half applied to spring tuition.

Scholarship applicants should have completed at least one semester of college or university study and plan to continue the following fall semester. Specific scholarships available include the following:

Adams Family Foundation Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$2,500.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. To be eligible for original consideration, student must be awarded this scholarship as an incoming freshman.
3. Renewable up to 8 semesters with a minimum grade point average of 2.75 or above.
4. Resident of middle Tennessee, preferably from Rutherford and/or Cannon Counties.
5. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Agriculture Endowment Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$1,000.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.8 or above.
3. Sophomore, junior or senior.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Alexander, Robert, Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$500.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.8 or above.

3. Sophomore, junior or senior.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Bigger, Theodore C., Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$800.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major. Preferably a Plant Science Major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 3.0 or above.
3. Preferably a sophomore.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Burum, Hugh, Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$1,000.00 (3 available).

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.8 or above.
3. Sophomore or Junior as of the next fall semester.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Collegiate FFA Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$1,000.00, applied in full to fall tuition only.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.5 or above.
3. Must be a member of MTSU Collegiate FFA.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Dairy Science Club Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$250.00, applied in full to fall tuition only.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.5 or above.
3. Must be a member of the MTSU Dairy Science Club.

4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Ellington, Catherine, Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$500.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.8 or above.
3. Resident of middle Tennessee, preferably from Marshall County or surrounding Rutherford County.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Hayden Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$500.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.8 or above.
3. Sophomore, junior or senior.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Heritage Farm Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$900.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major, with major interest in dairy industry (career in production or marketing).
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.8 or above.
3. Preferably a Junior or Senior.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Scholarship award is \$500.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.8 or above.

3. Sophomore, junior or senior.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Moskovitz, Mark Allen, Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$500.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.8 or above.
3. Sophomore, Junior or Senior; preferably in Horse Science program.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Nickle, Fowler and Ruth, Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$1,000.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.8 or above.
3. Sophomore, Junior or Senior.
4. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Rowlett , Thomas Franklin, Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$500.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS student majoring in Animal Science, Plant and Soil Science or Pre-Vet.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.5 or above.
3. Junior or Senior.
4. Recipient should be a native of Rutherford County. In the event no native Rutherford County student is qualified/applying, a student from a surrounding county could be eligible.
5. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.
6. Criteria for award include 1/3 scholarship, 1/3 participation in departmental activities, and 1/3 on interest and involvement in livestock industry.

Tennessee Council of Cooperatives Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$500.00.

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major.
2. Minimum grade point average of 3.0 or above.
3. Junior.
4. Resident of Tennessee.
5. Student or parent must be a member of a cooperative.
6. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities and economic need.

Tennessee Farmers Cooperative Scholarship

Scholarship award is \$1,500.00 (5 available).

Requirements:

1. Full-time ABAS major; student will forfeit balance of scholarship if major is changed to non-agriculture subject area.
2. Minimum grade point average of 2.5 or above.
3. Open to all undergraduate classifications, one freshman minimum.
4. Resident of Tennessee.
5. Parents must be a member of a local county co-op.
6. Consideration will also be given to academic performance, extracurricular activities (4-H, FFA, and college student organizations) and economic need.
7. An internship is NOT required for receipt of this scholarship.

Tennessee Farmers Cooperative Scholarship Recipient Internship

Internships for scholarship recipients are available. Placement in an internship is dependent on arrangements being worked out with a local Tennessee co-op. Student must be a sophomore or junior to qualify for internships. The internship term will be 12 weeks, spent working at a local member Tennessee co-op. If chosen, the recipient could spend one additional summer on internship. A one-day leadership training program is included in the internship term.
