








Video as a learning resource

- Panopto (*default)
- D2L
- Zoom (-)
- Youtube (-)
- Other cloud services (-)

Using Panopto & PPT

- Open D2L class folder
- Click on Videos
- Panopto will open class folder
- Click on + Create
- Open PPT Presentation
 - Cameo camera
 - Present in PPT
- Record with Panopto recorder
 - start recording (F8)
 - end recording (F10)
- The video will be available to students in the class only.
- Video can be "shared" or "copied" to other classes




Panopto recordings are automatically archived 13 months after the last view.



Using Zoom in D2L -> Panopto

- Schedule Zoom in D2L class
 - Make sure to select Record to cloud
- Start Zoom session within D2L
- Zoom session will start recording automatically
- After ending the Zoom session, Zoom will process the recording
- Panopto will automatically import recording into Panopto class folder







Using Prezi & Panopto

- Install Prezi Video and login (free account)
- Create your Prezi Presentation online
- Click on Create & Share a Video
- Click on Record, then Start Recording
- Advanced slides and click Done Recording.
 Click on Save video.
- Download video (*paid version)
- *Trick: Play video full screen and use a free screen recording program (FreeCam8) to capture the presentation video & audio.
- Upload to Panopto







Using One Button Studio +

- One Button Studio + (BAS S202)
- See instructions in our <u>website</u>
- A simple and easy to use video recording room that allows you to create high quality, polished video projects without having any previous experience or specialized knowledge.
- Available to College of Business faculty & staff.
- Also available to the general MTSU users.
- Used by reservation (first come first served).
- Check with your departmental administrative assistant or Carlos Coronel to reserve the room.
- Video is saved in an USB drive to upload to Panopto or other system.








Using Panopto Mobile

- Start recording with Panopto
- Add video sources using the Panopto recording app (phone, iPad, laptop, etc.)
- Join a Session in Progress
- Click on record to add video to the session (starting at that time mark)
- Panopto supports up to 6 video channels in a session
- Edit in Panopto to apply focus to the video source you desire.
- Viewers can switch video sources



Final thoughts...



accessible on a multitude

of devices including

laptops, tablets and

smartphones.

Shorter clips (around 5 to 10 minutes) help students learn the information without being overloaded.



In conclusion

- Students expect some video lecture content in their classes
- Recommend having at least an introductory video
- Create weekly short class update videos
- Use Panopto for:
 - Recording & sharing videos (Panopto VMS) stats & easy sharing
 - Basic editing: cutting videos, captions, chapter list, focus, etc.
 - Create video quiz for students & send grade to D2L grade book
 - Distributed recording multiple cameras (up to 5)
- Use the One Button Studio to easily create videos for class
- Use D2L Video Notes (quick but no percent stats, no editing, no easy sharing across classes)
- Use CapCut, Camtasia, Captivate, OBS, etc., for advanced editing (add titles, subtitles, effects, text and image overlays, etc.)
- Use AI tools for special cases
