

## Pre-Health Information Management/UT-Memphis

The pre-health information management program recommended below is specifically for the health information program at **University of Tennessee, Memphis** — College of Allied Health Sciences. You may obtain an admissions information sheet for University of Tennessee, Memphis Health Information Management Department from the Coordinator in the Davis Science Building, Room 241. If you plan to apply to other schools, please contact the institutions. Information on pre-health information management is available in DSB 241.

To gain the best first-hand knowledge about health information management, you should contact health information managers (medical record administrators), visit their facilities, and talk to them directly. Working in an office of health information management on a paid or volunteer basis is recommended.

**Application deadline is March 1 for the fall class.** In the fall semester of your third year you should schedule an appearance before the MTSU Preprofessional Advisory Committee. Contact the Coordinator in DSB 241 to make the arrangement, which includes obtaining recommendations from three to five professors.

The program requires three years of study (**ninety-semester** hour minimum) at MTSU followed by one calendar year at University of Tennessee, Memphis. Successful completion of the entire program will entitle the student to receive a Bachelor of Science degree in Health Information Management granted by the University of Tennessee.

Activity courses such as PHED or M.S. and skill courses such as typing, **may not** be used toward satisfying the 90 hour minimum at The University of Tennessee, Memphis.

**Course selection must include a minimum of 16 semester hours of 3000 - 4000 level courses.**

**Verification of one year of American History at the high school or college level is required.**
