

<u>PUBLIC NOTICE – MTSU PETITION FOR WAIVER</u> FORREST HALL NAME CHANGE

Middle Tennessee State University, a locally governed public institution of higher education, hereby gives public notice of its intention to petition the Tennessee Historical Commission for a waiver that would allow it to rename Forrest Hall, a building on its Murfreesboro campus built in 1954 and officially named for Confederate Lieutenant General Nathan Bedford Forrest in 1958, to the Army ROTC Building. While under the governance of the Tennessee Board of Regents, the university initiated a request to rename the building, which the Tennessee Historical Commission declined to permit. The University, as authorized by its Board of Trustees, now petitions to rename Forrest Hall based upon changed circumstances in the law or facts which demonstrate a material or substantial need based on historical or other compelling public interest to justify the waiver petition.
