The Health & Human Performance Graduate Program Office in Alumni Memorial Gym, room 209 (telephone 615-898-2147) **must be notified 24 hours in advance** if a student has registered to sit for the comprehensive exams and is unable to take them.

GRADING: A grade of Pass (P) or Fail (F) is given on the overall exam. Some students may be required to complete an oral exam and will be contacted by the department to schedule the oral review. If the overall exam is graded as Fail, students are given the opportunity to take **new** questions within three weeks or in the following semester.

*Normally, the comprehensive examination may be taken **no more than twice**, and failure to pass the comprehensive on the second attempt terminates one's degree program. Any exception to this "twice-only" rule must be recommended by the graduate program and approved by the dean of the College of Graduate Studies. (2010-2012 Graduate Catalog, page 47). This policy applies if you choose to retake the exam within three weeks **or** in the following semester.*
