Call for Papers:

If you are an undergraduate or graduate student and would like to present your research at the 2012 Tennessee Regional Conference, please send a one-page prospectus (by mail or email) with the following information:

- **Your contact information (name, address, phone number, and email)**
 - **Your college/university and whether you are a graduate or undergraduate**
- **A problem statement that highlights the significance of your research**
 - **A sketch of your claim and major reasons**
 - **A summary of your most important evidence**

Deadline for submitting paper proposals is 15 February 2012.

Full panel proposals are especially welcome (2-3 papers organized around a similar topic or methodology).
