**Title IX of the
Educational
Amendments of
1972**

Facilities, programs, and services sponsored by Middle Tennessee State University are available to all eligible persons regardless of race, color, age, sex, national origin, religion, disability or veteran status.

Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972, is the Federal Law that prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex in education programs, or activities that receive or benefit from Federal Financial Assistance.



Section 901a of Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972, provides specifically that:

No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any educational program or activity receiving Federal Financial Assistance.

Middle Tennessee State University is an equal opportunity, non-racially identifiable educational institution that does not discriminate against individuals with disabilities.
