
Instructions for accessing the Anytime/Anywhere Discussion Forum

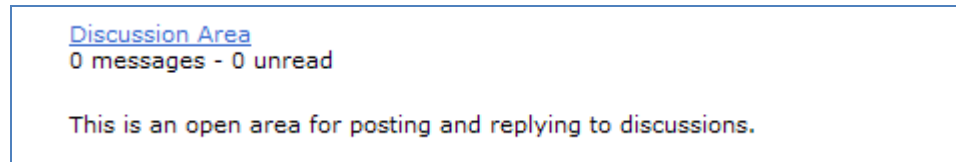
4. View the courses in this area. If you see multiple semesters, click on the (+) plus sign in front of "No semester". Click on the "University Leadership Council" course link.
