Comments on the Liberal Arts UDF template:

1. All text on the form can be edited, but try to retain as much of the original structure as possible.
2. Rows can be added to tables by placing the cursor in a cell of a row then clicking on Table, Insert, Rows Above or Table, Insert, Rows Below. Rows can be deleted by placing the cursor in any cell of a row then clicking Table, Delete, Row. If additional table segments are needed, existing segments can be copied and pasted then edited.
3. Many fields of the form, such as degree, major and/or concentration, specific Gen Ed courses, major requirements, and total hours, can be completed by the department before making the form available to students.
4. Some fields may not apply to all programs.
5. The "semester" field can be used to indicate when a course was or will be completed. The "Notes" field can be used to indicate when a substitution has been made. However, the Records Office asks that a fully signed Course Substitution Form also be submitted.
