- You must earn a "C" or better in each course marked candidacy (A grade of "C-" will NOT meet candidacy requirements)
- A 2.0 cumulative GPA is required to earn a degree from MTSU
- You must earn at least 80 hours outside the College of Mass Communication in order to graduate.
- You must earn at least 65 Liberal Arts and Sciences credit in order to graduate
- You must complete **TWO** minors to graduate
