Degrees require a minimum of:

- (1) 120 semester hours with at least a 2.0 grade point average; 12 of the last 18 hours must be taken at MTSU - not transferred;
- (2) 42 upper-division hours (3000-4000 level courses) with at least a 2.0 grade point average; 30 upper-division hours must be taken at MTSU - not transferred; and
- (3) 60 senior college hours (taken at a four-year college).

Courses used to fulfill high school deficiencies can only be counted as general ELECTIVE credit - not specific course requirements.

** Any course substitutions must be approved on an MTSU Course Substitution form with appropriate advisor, department chair, and college dean signatures.
