## Three Summer Grants!

*Offered by the President's Commission on the Status of Women*

Three summer grants in the amount of \$1,800 each are available for the integration of the experiences and perspectives of women into the curriculum. The grants are intended for use in the summer of 2010 by tenured or tenure-track faculty members who wish to pursue one of the following projects:

- revision of a course
- revision of a general education course for Study Abroad program
- creation of a new course
- re-conceptualization of a current minor
- creation of a new minor

Proposals will be reviewed by selected members serving on the Academic Issues Subcommittee of the President's Commission on the Status of Women. Successful proposals have often incorporated innovative teaching techniques and integrated women's concerns with issues of race/ethnicity, class and sexual orientation. Priority will be given to courses that can be implemented within two years and those that are developed or revised for the undergraduate curriculum.

Grant recipients will be required to present the completed project at the Commission's meeting to be held at the beginning of the Fall 2010 semester. Also, recipients will be required to provide the Academic Issues Subcommittee with a copy of the finished syllabus, course proposal, minor proposal, or revised minor no later than the fall meeting.
