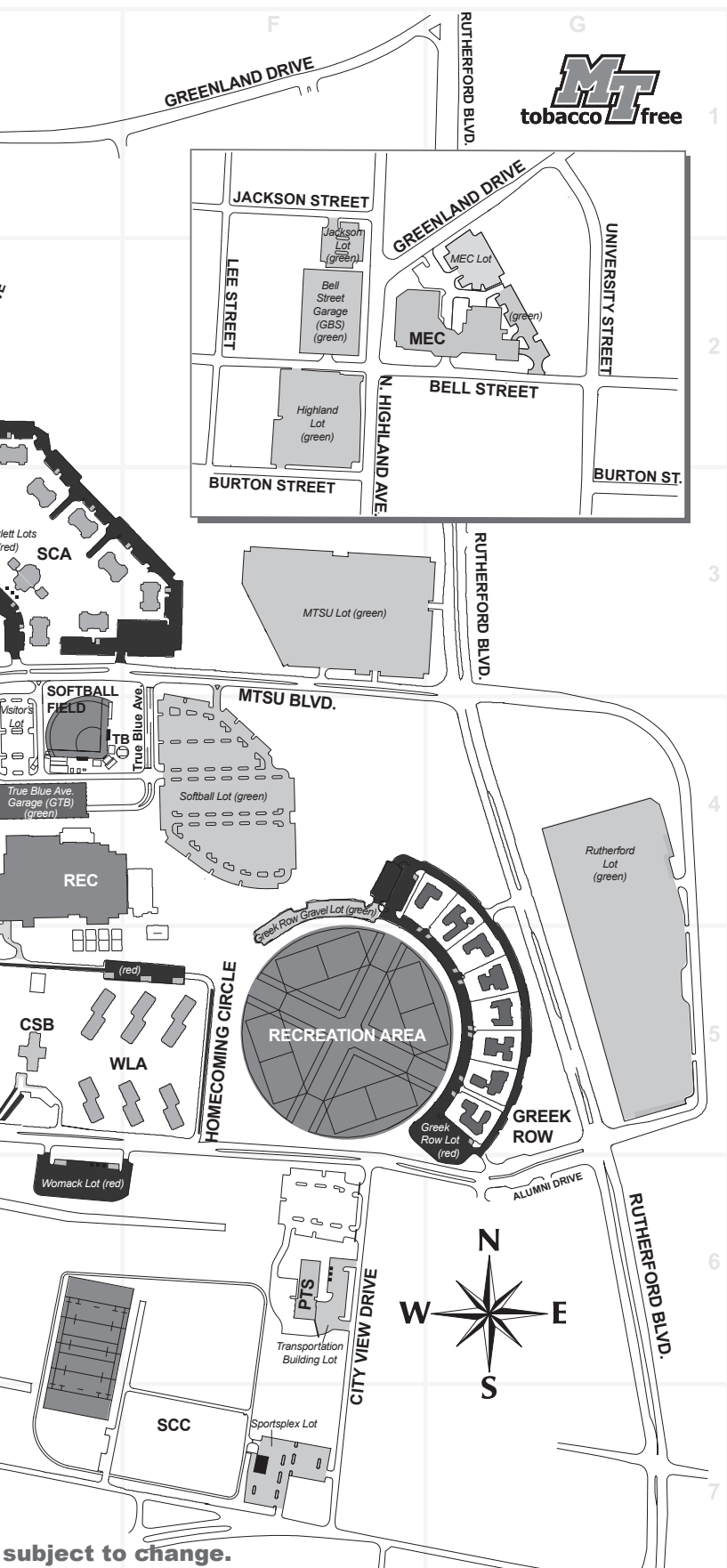

## Send in your immunization records

MTSU requires full-time students to provide proof of two (2) doses of Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) vaccine and two (2) doses of Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine or proof of immunity or documentation of disease history from a health care provider. ## Submit proof of U.S. citizenship
