## A Bill to Eliminate Additional Fees at the Campus Recreation Center

Whereas: Students without official student identification cards are denied admittance to the Campus Recreation Center (with the exception of one admittance without card every four months).

Whereas: Students enrolled in the university have already been charged to use the facility.

Whereas: The Campus Recreation Center charges students without official identification \$3 for entry to the center.

Whereas: The purpose of identifying students at the entrance of the facility is to verify their proof of payment.

Whereas: The Campus Recreation Center has an on-hand index of enrolled students.

Whereas: Students could use, as a secondary source of identification, their driver's license and student identification number to verify their proof of payment.

Therefore let it be enacted, by the 65<sup>th</sup> Congress of the Student Government Association of Middle Tennessee State University, that:

**Section 1:** The Campus Recreation Center will permit students with secondary identification into the facility without additional fees.

Section 2: This bill shall take effect immediately upon approval, the student welfare requiring it.
