SGA Bill No. 8-03-F

A bill to remove Senator Khanthaly Phrommala from representing the college of Education and Behavioral Sciences.

Whereas: Senator Phrommala missed three consecutive meetings unexcused.

Whereas: The attendance requirements for retaining a Senate seat stipulate that no Senator is allowed to miss two consecutive meetings unexcused.

Whereas: Senator Phrommala has made no attempt to contact the Speaker or the committee as to why she was not in attendance at these meetings.

Whereas: Because Senator Phrommala failed to meet her obligations as a Senator in the MTSU SGA, she should be removed from office.

Therefore, let it be resolved by the 66th SGA Congress that:

Section 1. Upon a 2/3 vote in favor of removal, Khanthaly Phrommala shall be removed from office with the understanding that, in accordance of Article 9, Section 3, Letter C, she shall never pursue any other office within the SGA for the remainder of her attendance at MTSU.
