A Resolution to stop graffiti on campus by students, organizations and members of the community.

Whereas: Flyers are being taped and/or stapled to unauthorized areas on campus diminishing the natural beauty of MTSU.

Whereas: Sidewalk chalk is being used on the sides of buildings and not on the sidewalks. This graffiti stays visible longer than if it were written on the sidewalks.

Whereas: Stickers and spray-paint designs are being put on to various objects on campus. These two things are very costly and time consuming to remove.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 67TH CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MTSU THAT:

Section 1: Any person(s) caught spray-painting or placing stickers on any object on campus be prosecuted to the fullest extent of law.

Section 2: Any student/student organization that post flyers or use sidewalk chalk in/on inappropriate areas shall be sent to the Dean of Judicial Affairs for disciplinary action. Any member of the community participating in the aforementioned offenses be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law and banned from campus for no sooner than a calendar year.

Section 3: Any student, organization or community member wishing to solicit or promote any agenda must obtain written permission from the Dean of Student Affairs declaring the time and location of their advertisement. This permission must be on hand at all times.

Section 4: All various campaign signs fall under section 3.
