Section 1: A 1:00 A.M. curfew limiting Homecoming activities will be implemented Sunday through Thursday throughout the Homecoming preparation period.

Section 2: The curfew will not apply the night before the Homecoming event takes place.

Section 3: The Homecoming committee will be responsible for enforcing the curfew.

Section 4: If an organization is found in violation of curfew, it will be disqualified from that particular event.
