THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 76th CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: The Executive Vice President of SGA shall oversee the pairing of Senate mentors with

Freshman Council mentees.

Section 2: Freshman council mentees are to be paired with mentors to the best of the Executive

Vice-Presidents ability.

Section 3: The SGA Executive Vice President reserves the right to remove Senators from the

position of Freshman Council mentor if they fail to fulfill the role of mentor and appoint

a replacement Senate mentor.

Section 4: Senators are not required to participate in the Freshman Council mentor program. If no

senators are willing to participate in the program, the Executive Vice President will

appoint senators to be mentors.
