“Black. White.” to Come to MTSU

“Black.White.” has been rescheduled for April 23, 2007, at 7pm in MTSU’s Tucker Theater. In a series executive produced by R.J. Cutler and Ice Cube for FX, two all-American families--one black, one white--live together under one roof in the urban melting pot of Los Angeles. This series explores the complexities of race relations lurking under the surface in contemporary America.

“I didn’t realize, more than anything, how hard it was going to be for whites and blacks to see the world through each other’s eyes,” said executive producer R.J. Cutler. “I didn’t realize how genuinely

- *Must have waited 56 days since last blood donation.*
