Angela Mertig's (PhD, Washington State University, 1995), areas of interest include the environment, animals and society, and social movements. She has several publications on the environmental movement, natural resource management and the treatment of animals, from farm animals to wildlife. Professor Mertig's current research focuses on the use and recycling of motor oil; attitudes on water quality issues; possible strategies for black bear recovery in Texas; and the use of rodenticides. She has been conducting surveys and working with former graduate students on a number of projects. Dr. Mertig is very active on the MTSU campus and in her community and is also the Graduate Program Director for the Sociology Department at MTSU.
