

Other Factors (Cross tabulation with Where a Student Chose to Live).

The following table provides data related to **Residence Choice** and **Other Factors**.

This table shows the relationship between where a student chose to live and **other factor(s)** that may have impacted the student's residence choice. For example, 48% of the students who indicated they would live "On-Campus," said that "Low-cost" was important to them. While 71% of the parents who indicated their student would live "On-Campus," said that "Low-Cost" was important in making a residency choice.

Percentages are computed relative to the RESPONSE totals at the end of each ROW.
