

Policies (Cross Tabulation with Where a Student Chose to Live).

This table provides data related to **Residence Choice** and **On-Campus Policies**.

This table shows the relationship between where a student chose to live and the **policy(ies)** that may have impacted the student's residence choice. For example, 47% of the students who indicated they would live "On-Campus," said that the "Alcohol Policy" had an impact on that decision. While 94% of the parents who indicated their student would live "On-Campus," said that the "Alcohol Policy" had an impact on the student's residency choice.

Percentages are computed relative to the RESPONSE totals at the end of each ROW.
