

1. Title: Sparkle
2. Ages: seven and up
3. Content Standard: a). English 3.03 Demonstrate knowledge of standard English spelling. b). Theater level III Ensemble and interpersonal skills-Develop skills of cooperation and interaction through dramatic activities.
4. Materials: none required
5. Instructions: As a spelling word game, students get into a circle or a line. The teacher says a word and the first student will begin spelling with the first letter of the word and the second student will say the second letter of the word and so on. When the word is spelled the student that is next after the last letter of the word is given then that student says the word “Sparkle” and then the student next in line to the “Sparkle” student is out and must sit down. If a student misses a letter in a word or gives the wrong letter then they are also out and the game continues onto the next player. The game ends when there is only one student left.
