

Middle Tennessee State University Flight Training Cost Summary

Note: The required hours of flight and ground instruction for each flight course, along with the course cost based on those hours, is indicated below. Based on historical data, some students may need more than the required hours of training to be proficient and able to pass their FAA check ride for a particular course. Students are required to deposit the minimum amount indicated on the last (italicized) line of each certificate cost summary into their flight account prior to beginning training for that course. Students using VA benefits for flight training costs do not have to make this deposit, but are only eligible for reimbursement of the required hours indicated below. Any hours incurred above these hours will be the financial responsibility of the VA-funded student.
