Can Do Crew Newsletter September 26, 2011

Well, fall began and all seems to be going as planned. Enrollment remained steady at 26,000 plus. And, as is most often the case, the Can Do Crew was well prepared to meet the start of classes.

We ended last year without having to make any additional budget cuts to meet state appropriation reductions and the challenge of no longer having the benefit of federal stimulus funds. As I have said several times, we planned well and carefully managed the budget reductions. Barring any new state economic downturn, we hopefully will not have any additional state appropriation reductions.

We continue to participate in the ongoing state and higher education efforts to meet the requirements of the Complete College Tennessee Act of 2010. In that regard we will be participating in the Tennessee College Completion Academies. This is a joint effort of Governor Bill Haslam, the Tennessee Higher Education Commission, the Tennessee Board of Regents, the University of Tennessee and the Tennessee Business Roundtable to help the state increase its production of postsecondary credentials in the years ahead.

Now on a more personal and positive note, we did receive a 3% salary increase effective July 1, 2010. Also, the Tennessee Board of Regents approved at its meeting last week some additional salary plan increases effective January 1, 2012. Not all employees, however, will receive increases. It just depends on where your current salary is in the compensation plan. The primary application is to bring any employee below the current market minimum up to that minimum. Additionally, the Board approved a \$1,000 bonus for full-time regular employees and a prorated amount for regular part-time employees. The bonus will be paid in our October paycheck. Further, if you are not aware, the state legislature did approve to continue to give state employees, including higher education employees, the longevity payment.

Your support of the Image Committee is appreciated; and I hope you are able to participate in the Can Do Crew events being planned this year, including the Chili Challenge at the football homecoming game October 1st.

As always, thank you for being a Business and Finance Can Do Crew member; and if you have a concern or recommendation, please do not hesitate to let your supervisor or me know.

Notwithstanding the many issues that we face, please continue, as I do, to be thankful for our jobs and the blessings that we have.




















































