Can Do Crew Newsletter October 2012

With the recent cool weather it seems that winter may be just around the corner. Fall semester began though with very few issues except enrollment was slightly down. As usual, the Can Do Crew was well prepared.

As mentioned in a message earlier this year, our current fiscal year budget once again had a state funding reduction. New funding for improvements under the state funding formula did make up for that reduction. We are not yet certain what the Tennessee Higher Education Commission may propose at its next month's meeting. Hopefully, with recent state revenue improvements new funding based the funding formula will again be provided and there will be no general state appropriation reduction.

We did receive a 2.5% salary increase effective July 1, 2012, which I know everyone appreciated. Also, the Tennessee Board of Regents approved at its meeting last month some additional salary plan increases effective January 1, 2013. Not all employees, however, will receive an increase. It just depends on where current salary is in the compensation plan. The primary application is to bring employees closer to market salaries.

Further, as requested by President McPhee to recognize years of dedicated MTSU service, the Board approved an additional one-time service payment. The payment will be \$100 per year of MTSU service up to maximum of \$1,000 per full-time employee, pro-rated for part-time employees, who had at least 2 years of service with MTSU as of September 30, 2012 and were in active employment status on September 30, 2012. Any partial year of at least six (6) months service will count as a full year of service. That payment will be included in our October salary payment.

Additionally, if you were not aware, the state legislature did approve to continue to give state employees, including higher education employees, the longevity payment.

Please continue your support of the Image Committee and participate in Can Do Crew events this year. Many did attend the recent football homecoming game.

Thank you for being a Business and Finance Can Do Crew member; and if you have a concern or recommendation, please do not hesitate to let your supervisor or me know.

As always, we should be thankful for our jobs and the many blessings that we have and thank the students with whom we have contact for attending MTSU.
