Fraud occurs when the *opportunity* exists to react to perceived or real *pressure*

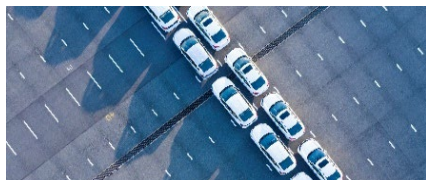
through **criminal** behavior, often accompanied by attempts to *rationalize* the actions taken.

According to the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners (ACFE) 2020 Report to the Nations, Education ranks **6<sup>th</sup>** out of 23 industries for reported cases of Fraud.

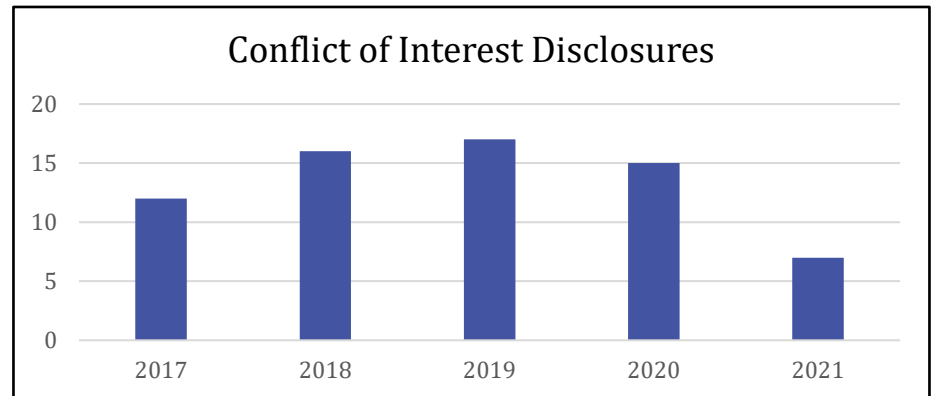


## HOW WELL DO YOU KNOW POLICY 12?

### \*Important distinction\*

The mere existence of either a potential or actual conflict of interest does **not** mean that such a conflict must necessarily be eliminated, but it **must** be disclosed using the Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form.
