Camper Requirements and Expectations

Thank you for your interest in sending your child to the MTSU Inclusive College Experience summer day camp. Campers must be between the ages of 16 and 25 years old and must meet the following requirements.

- Have a documented developmental or intellectual disability.
- Completed or currently attending high school under an IEP.
- Demonstrate a first-grade reading level.
- Able to function independently without one-on-one assistance.
- Able to maintain personal needs, including managing any required specialized dietary and/or medical needs.
- Can function independently for at least one hour.
- Able to communicate with others.
- Willing to follow reasonable rules and instructions.
- Have sufficient emotional stability to participate in all camp and campus activities.
- Have transportation to and from the campus.
- NOT demonstrate any physical aggression or violence towards staff or other campers - physical violence of any kind is grounds for immediate termination from the program.
- Physically capable of walking to multiple locations across campus

Note: All camp staff are volunteers, and some counselors will be under the age of 18. We are not able to manage/administer medications. If it becomes clear that a camper cannot or will not appropriately participate in camp activities, then the parent or guardian will be called to take them home.
