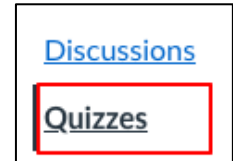
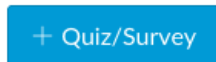


Creating New Quizzes in Canvas

New Quizzes is an advanced assessment engine that integrates with Canvas as an LTI tool, offering a variety of question types, including Hotspot, Ordering, Categorization, and Stimulus questions.

1. Go to the **Quizzes** in your Course Navigation menu.
2. Click the + **Quiz/Survey** button.

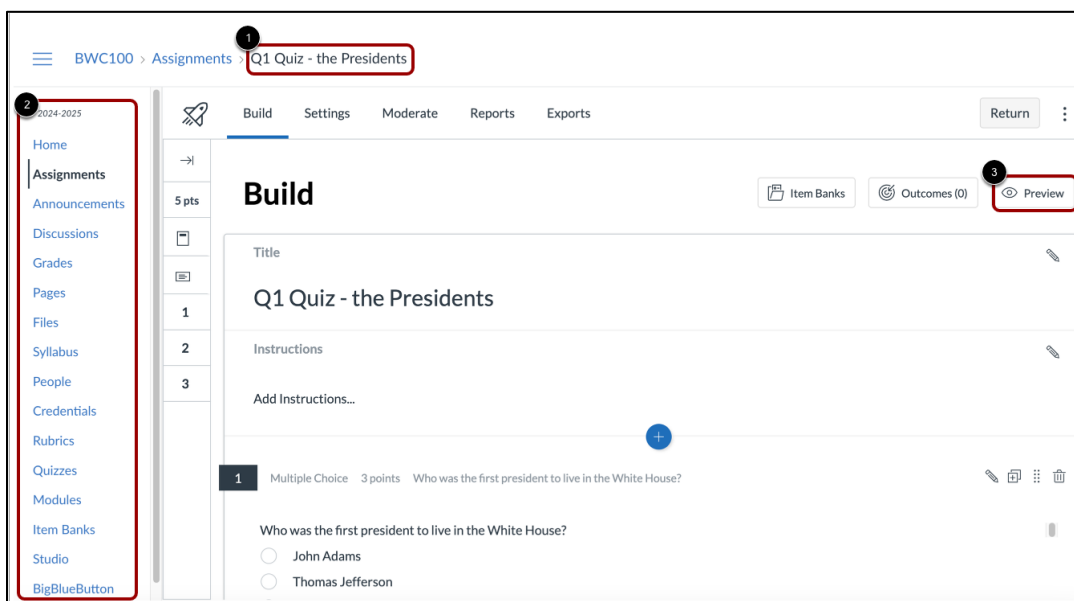


3. Complete the **Assignment details...**

- **Assignment Name:** Enter a name for the Quiz.
- **Quiz Type:** Select the type of quiz from the following choices:
 - **Graded Quiz:** This is the standard assessment where points are assigned for correct answers, and the overall score is recorded in the gradebook.¹²
 - **Graded Survey:** This type assigns points for simply submitting the quiz, regardless of the answers. It creates a column in the gradebook.¹

- **Ungraded Survey:** This type has no points assigned and does not create a column in the gradebook. If you enter a zero point value for a survey, you'll see an option to hide the quiz from the Gradebook
- **Assignment Group:** If you are grouping your assignments for grade weighting, you can select which group the quiz should be assigned.
- **Display Grade As:** Allows instructors to choose how the grade will appear in the Gradebook (Points, Percentage, Complete/Incomplete, Letter Grade, etc)
- **Do not count this assignment towards the final grade:** Check this box if you do not wish to include this quiz as part of the student's overall grade.

4. When creating or editing a New Quiz, you can view the Quiz Title [1], the Course Navigation [2], and the View as Student button [3].



5. To close your quiz and return to the Quizzes page, click the **Return** button.
