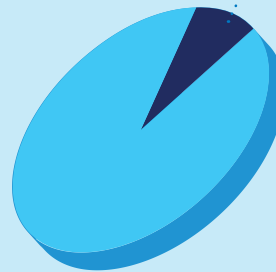


The 1st Destination Survey is a very brief survey open to MTSU graduates from graduation to three months after. The results indicate what students are doing or planning to do after graduation. 1st destination surveys are administered to assist in the accreditation process, comply with federal regulations, and provide data on outcomes for recent graduates. The Annual Report for the 1st Destination Survey includes outcomes for August and December graduations in the same calendar year and the May graduation of the following calendar year.

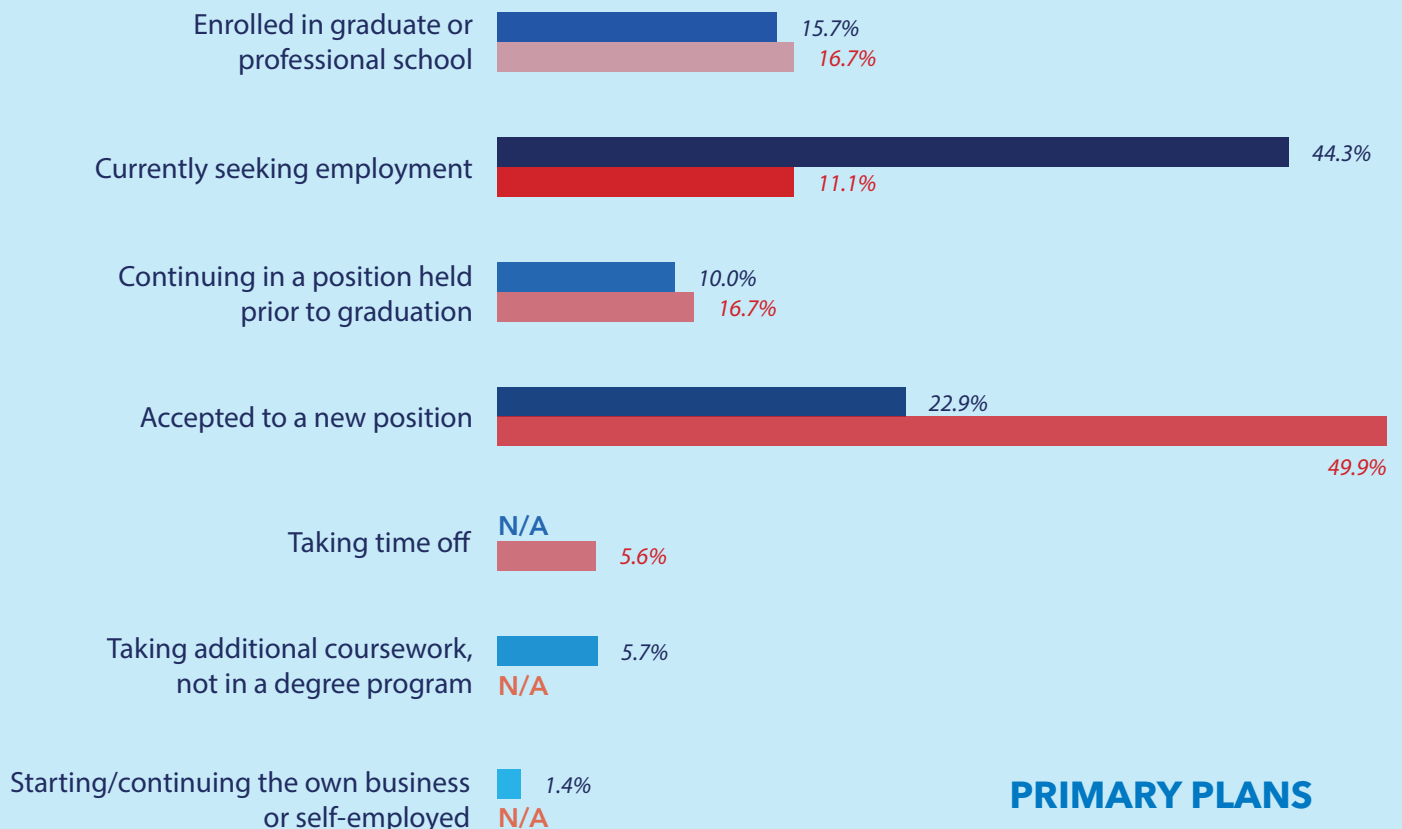
The MTSU Office of Institutional Effectiveness, Planning and Research (IEPR) will begin conducting the 1st Destination Survey for the December 2019 graduating class.
