Hello Future Teachers!

Your Academic Advising Team in the College of Education is working hard to prepare for what we call peak advising. This is the dedicated time that we set aside to meet with you individually to discuss how your semester is going, chat about various resources that may be helpful to you, and to make sure that you are on track to register for next semester.

Priority Registration is the two weeks during the semester where currently enrolled students (YOU!) register for future terms. You will be assigned a dedicated **Registration Date and Time** based on the number of credit hours that you have earned. This date and time will probably be available to you around Fall Break when the **Registration Guide** for Spring is published. So, be watching your email closely for the announcement from the university (and from us, your favorite advising team!).

So that you can register on your assigned registration date and time, we want to meet with you **BEFORE Priority Registration**. Be watching for an email from your assigned academic advisor to **schedule your academic advising appointment** as soon as you can so that your advising hold is removed and are able to register at your assigned time without delay! You will also want to schedule your appointment as early as possible because we do have to travel with the university throughout the fall semester, especially during October.

Test Taking Tips

As you start the exam, take control!

1. Listen closely to directions.
2. Look over the entire test and read carefully each section.
3. Budget time accordingly.
4. Build confidence by answering questions you know first.
5. Mark questions you are unsure of and recheck later.
6. Your first guess may not always be the best.
7. Some questions may jog your memory or provide answers to other questions, so carefully review everything!
8. Know what the question asks for before selecting an answer. Don't be afraid to underline or circle parts of the question to help understand the question.
9. If something looks to be a typo, but you are not sure, ask the teacher. It may not be a typo.
10. Scan any text, figures, charts, or drawings that accompany a question; then, read the questions to see what information you will need. Next, return to the drawings for a more careful reading.
11. Answer every question. A blank answer is always wrong, a guess may be right.
