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### WITHDRAWING OPTIONS

Beginning Feb. 1., 2022

Any student dropping a class or classes can do so on Pipeline up to March 27th and will receive a grade of W (for full-term classes). The "W" grade does not impact your GPA but does count as attempted hours. Refer to the [Registration Guide](#) for accelerated dates.

Through Feb. 13th students dropping a full-term class will receive a 25% fee adjustment. After that, there will be no adjustment. Students with financial aid should consult the MT One Stop *before* withdrawing, as well as your academic advisor.

## PLANNING AHEAD! COE SUMMER 2022 COURSE OPTIONS

**Elementary Students:** The summer ELED 3000/3100 is a great option for any students in EESE 2010/2011 last semester or this semester. With a little advanced planning, some students may be able to take the EESE courses in May, apply for candidacy, and then take the ELED courses in June. *However*, you will need to have satisfactory test scores by April 20th to get your scores back by May 20th to enroll in the June class by the first week of June. A pretty tight timeline. See your advisor if interested.

**All COE Students:** If you were not able to get into EESE this spring, but believe you will have all other candidacy application requirements met by the end of spring, you can opt to take EESE 2010/2011 this May and apply for candidacy at the end of the term. There may still be candidacy courses open for fall at that point to help you speed up your graduation timeline. See your advisor if interested.
