The highlights below are based on Spring 2006 enrollment. We welcome your comments, reactions, and suggestions as a means of improving future editions.

H I G H L I G H T S

- The University enrolled 20,951 students in the Spring semester.
- Seventy-six (76) percent of all students enrolled are full-time and twenty-four (24) percent are part-time.
- Undergraduates represent ninety (90) percent and graduates represent ten (10) percent of our total enrollment.
- Ninety-three (93) percent of all students are residents of Tennessee.
- Minority students represent eighteen (18) percent of the University's enrollment.
- Women are a majority at the University, accounting for fifty-three (53) percent of enrollment.
- Enrollment of adult learners is 10,399 which constitutes fifty (50) percent of our total enrollment.
- Enrollment of 10,277 evening students represents forty-nine (49) percent of the student body; of the evening students 8,869 (86%) are undergraduate and 1,408 (14%) are graduate students.
- A total of 5,005 students take classes via alternative delivery methods. These students, which represent twenty-four (24) percent of our total student enrollment, generate a total of 14,806 credit hours.
- The average age of our students is 25.
