Pursuant to 34 CFR [§668.43](#), Middle Tennessee State University (MTSU) provides the following disclosure related to the educational requirements for professional licensure and certification necessary for employment.

The Bachelor of Science in Aerospace, Flight Dispatch (BS Aerospace, Flight Dispatch) in the College of Basic and Applied Sciences is accredited by the Aviation Accreditation Board International (AABI) and is an approved Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) 14 CFR Part 65 Aircraft Dispatcher school. Admission to the BS Aerospace, Flight Dispatch does not guarantee that students will earn FAA Aircraft Dispatcher certification, which is required for degree completion.

FAA Aircraft Dispatcher Certification is a federally established license; therefore, the BS Aerospace, Flight Dispatch meets the educational requirements to seek FAA certification in all U.S. states and territories:
