Pursuant to 34 CFR [§668.43](#), Middle Tennessee State University (MTSU) provides the following disclosure related to the educational requirements for professional licensure and certification necessary for employment.

The Bachelor of Science in Aerospace, Maintenance Management (BS Aerospace, Maintenance Management) in the College of Basic and Applied Sciences is accredited by the Aviation Accreditation Board International (AABI) and is an approved Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) 14 CFR Part 147 Maintenance Technician school. Admission to the BS Aerospace, Maintenance Management does not guarantee that students will earn FAA Airframe and Powerplant certification, which is required for degree completion.

FAA Airframe and Powerplant Certification is a federally established license; therefore, the BS Aerospace Maintenance Management meets the educational requirements to seek FAA certification in all U.S. states and territories:
