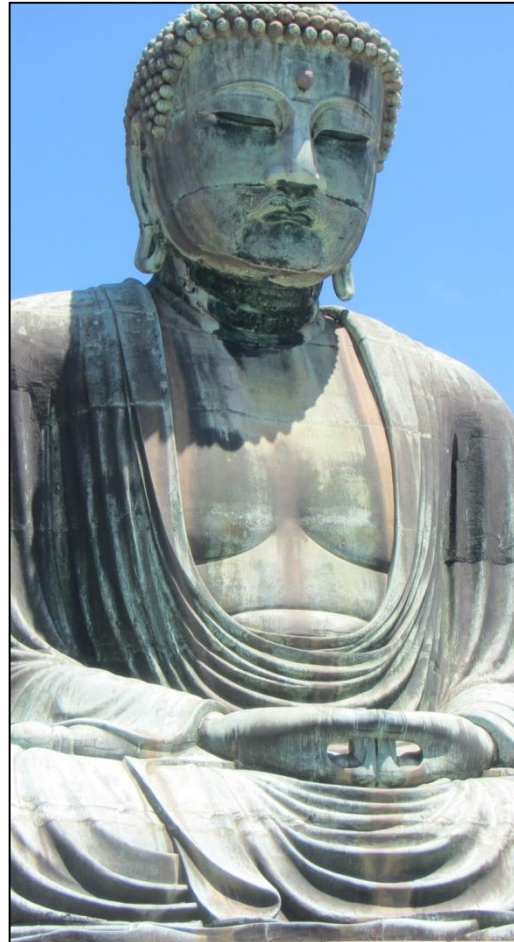
Estimated Program Fee \$2400.00
