Choirs under his direction have given invitational performances for National ACDA, National MENC (NAfME), Southwestern ACDA, MCDA, and multiple times for MMEA. He currently serves as Vice President of Southwestern ACDA. His first 25 years were spent teaching secondary music where his students consistently earned superior ratings at District and State Music Festivals. He then served 4 years as Director of Music Education at Drury University. He was awarded the 2012 Faculty Member of the Year award by the Student Government Association and the 2015 Faculty Member of the year by the Greek Life Association. After serving as Director of Choral Activities at Missouri Baptist University he now serves as the Director of Choirs and Department Chair at New Covenant Academy in Springfield, Missouri.
