Summer Grants!

Offered by the President's Commission on the Status of Women

Two summer grants in the amount of \$2,700 each are available for the integration of the experiences and perspectives of women into the curriculum. Curriculum Integration Grants are awarded to support the completion of one of the following projects:

- revision of a course
- revision of a general education course for Study Abroad program
- creation of a new course
- re-conceptualization of a current minor
- creation of a new minor

Proposals will be reviewed by selected members serving on the Academic Issues Subcommittee of the President's Commission on the Status of Women. Successful proposals should demonstrate a commitment to innovative teaching techniques as well as careful consideration of the intersection of women's concerns with notions of race/ethnicity, class, and sexual orientation. Priority will be given to courses that are developed or revised for the undergraduate curriculum and those that can be implemented within two years. Eligibility is limited to faculty who have not received a Curriculum Integration grant in the past four years.

Grant recipients will be required to present the completed project to both the President's Commission on the Status of Women and to the LT&ITC. Recipients will also be required to provide the committee with a copy of the finished syllabus, course proposal, minor proposal, or revised minor no later than the fall meeting of the President's Commission on the Status of Women.



The deadline for submission of proposals is Friday, March 19, 2021.
