

Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the Middle Tennessee State University MSW Program.

You must meet the following requirements to be eligible for regular program admission:

1. Graduation from an accredited college or university, with a bachelor's degree which includes coursework in the area of liberal arts
2. A cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher

You must meet the following requirements to be eligible for advanced standing admission:

1. Graduation from an accredited College or university, with a bachelor's degree in social work which is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education. There is no time limit on when the degree was received.
2. A cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Enrollment is limited.

***Review of completed applications begin October 15, 2022 for Spring Admission
and January 31, 2023 for Fall Admission***

Application Process for the MSW requires two steps:

1. Apply to the Graduate College: <https://www.mtsu.edu/graduate/forms.php> (“Application to Graduate Studies”). **This application is completed online. Your transcripts must be sent to the Graduate College.**

After submitting and paying for your application, your application will be processed by a graduation analysts. Once this occurs, you will receive an email from the College of Graduate Studies with further admissions instructions. You will receive your M Number and MTmail account in that email. Once you receive that information, you can set up your PipelineMT account and submit your admissions materials to the Graduate Student Portal

- Submit all admissions materials to your Graduate Student Portal. Please note that you cannot upload official transcripts or official test scores. Those must be sent directly to the College of Graduate Studies from the issuing institution. Social Work has a specific recommendation form. Notification of Admission Status

To be accepted into the program, you must meet the admissions requirements of both the Graduate College and the MSW program. This administrative process is as follows:

- 1) The Graduate College will determine whether you meet the minimum qualifications for admission to graduate studies and will notify the MSW Admissions Committee.
- 2) The MSW Admissions Committee will review those applications approved by the Graduate College as meeting minimum admission criteria, select the individuals for admission, and notify the Graduate College of the decision.

You will be notified by email regarding your admission status before or by November 15th. If you are placed on a waiting list, the admissions committee will notify you as well.
