

Each Submitted Appeal Must Include:

- The completed **appeal form** submitted either online (recommended) or in person.
- A **statement** of the factors that contributed to your academic difficulties in your most recent semester.
- A plan for **academic improvement** you would follow if your appeal is granted.
- **Other documentation**, if applicable, from third parties in support of your appeal may be included.

Complete the Summer/Fall 2026 paper appeal form available at the MT One Stop Front Desk and submit it together with the required (1) appeal statement and (2) plan for academic improvement in person to the MT One Stop by the May 18, 4:00 p.m. deadline.

IT IS EXPECTED THAT YOU READ THE FOLLOWING PROVIDED INFORMATION:

- If you attended another school while on suspension from MTSU, you are not eligible to submit an academic appeal but must submit a re-admit application and meet current undergraduate admissions standards.
- **To request a personal interview, be present by 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 20, 2026**, at the appropriate College of Education room to sign the roster for an interview. See page 2 for the specific room assigned to your college committee. A personal interview is not required. If you choose not to appear for a personal interview, your appeal packet will be reviewed and a decision made on May 20. **All students must submit the appeal form first by May 18 to be eligible to appear in person before the committee.**
- If you need to change your major you must contact the appropriate college advisor in time for them to submit a *Change of Major* form no later than **4:30 p.m. Friday, May 15**. Your appeal will be reviewed by the college academic appeal committee members based on your official major.
- The decision of the Academic Appeals Committee is **FINAL** and only valid for the term appealed. **The committee's decision cannot be overturned.** There is no higher appeal.
- If you appeal at the May meeting for the Fall 2026 semester and are denied, you cannot appeal again for Fall 2026 at the August meeting. If readmitted for Summer 2026 but you do not attend, you must appeal again at the August meeting for Fall 2026 if you wish to attend that semester.
- You will receive an e-mail when the results can be viewed in PipelineMT. Registration restrictions for students who were readmitted will be removed by the morning of Thursday, May 21. If readmitted, you should schedule an appointment with your advisor to discuss appropriate course selection.
- If you were not enrolled in Spring 2026 and your academic appeal is approved, you will need to complete an Admissions **re-enrollment** application online.
- If you are approved to return, this committee might impose conditions such as limiting your enrollment to 4, 8, or 14 credit hours for the term and/or requiring you to meet with your college advisor.
- Readmission by the Academic Appeals Committee does not imply reinstatement of financial aid, if applicable. There is a separate appeal process and deadline for financial aid if your aid has been suspended. Check the Financial Aid [webpage](#) for more details.
- Please be aware that if we become aware of an incident of sexual harassment or sexual violence at MTSU based on the contents of an appeal, we are responsible for reporting it to the appropriate authorities. It is the student's responsibility to follow-up and verify their appeal was received by verifying an appeal entry has been made in PipelineMT **PRIOR to the Monday, May 18, 2026, 4:00 p.m. deadline**.
