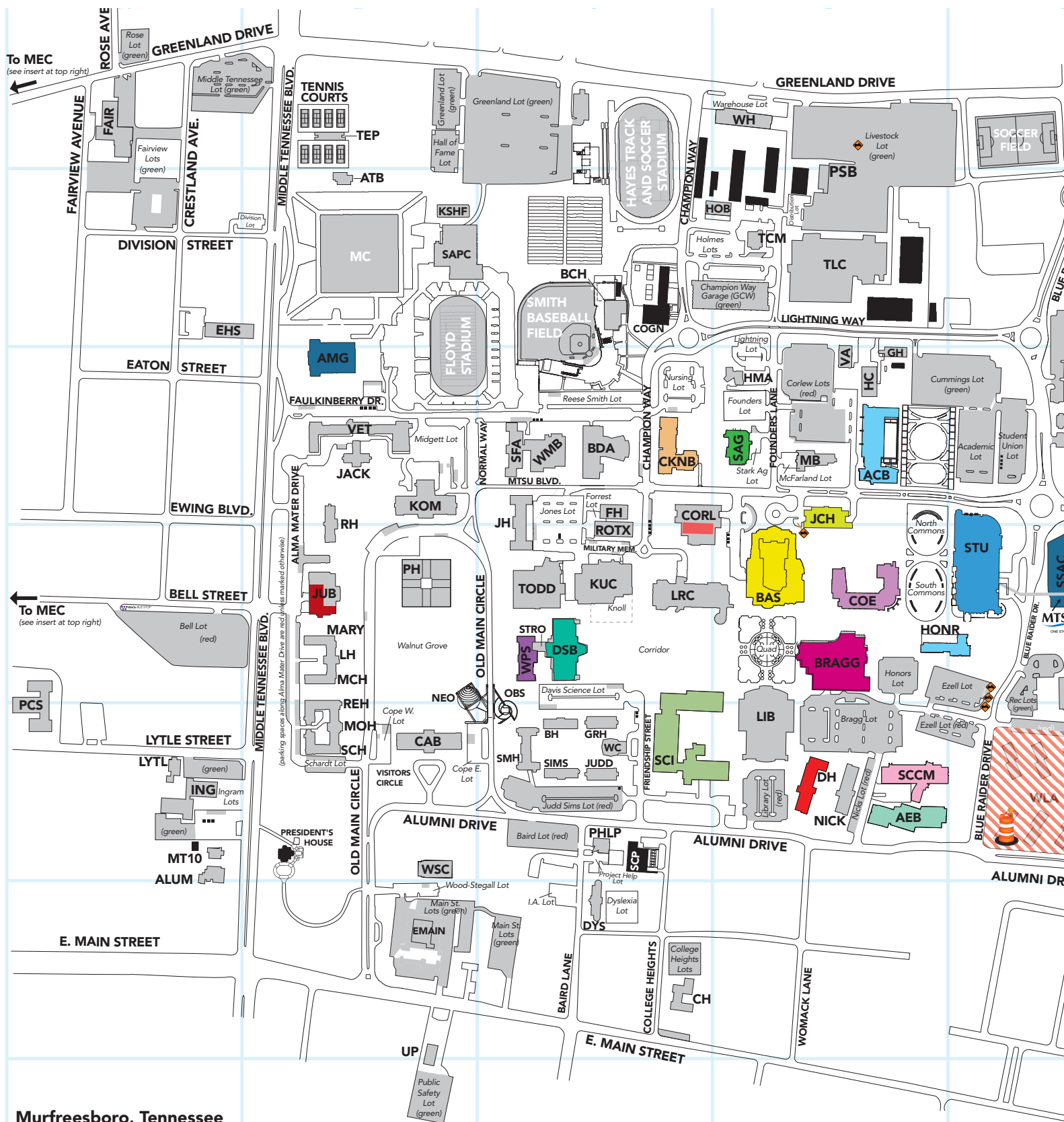

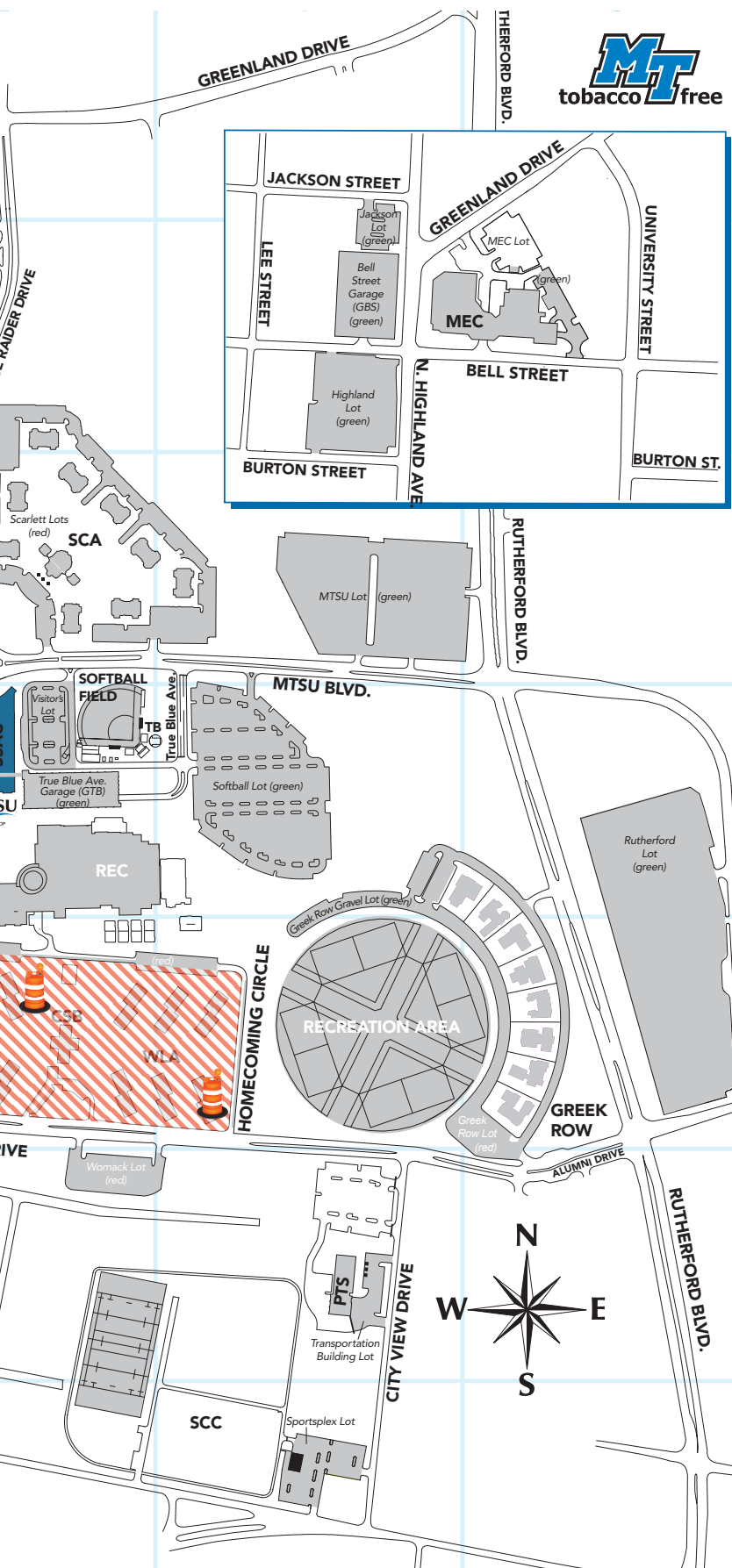

Apply as soon as possible. Housing assignments are made on a first-come, first-served basis. Application dates are available within the Important Dates section of the housing webpage.

Send in your immunization records

MTSU requires full-time students to provide proof of two (2) doses of Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) vaccine and two (2) doses of Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine or proof of immunity or documentation of disease history from a health care provider.
