

SGA Bill No. 1-06-F

A Bill to amend Article II of the Middle Tennessee State University Student Government Association Constitution by adding a Section 5, thus stating: "Any member of the SGA found to have behaved in a deliberate, willful contradiction of the principles and expectations of Sections 2 & 4 of Article II will be subject to impeachment."

Whereas: As Article II, the Statement of Governing Principles, states "...members of the Student Government Association shall conduct themselves in a manner deserving of the high level of trust that the student body places in their leadership", it is expected that members of the SGA be outstanding citizens of the MTSU community,

Whereas: Article II, Section 2 states that SGA members "will be good stewards of the University's resources and will not engage in conduct that damages or exploits the MTSU community,"

Whereas: Article II, Section 4 states that "SGA members will not engage in cheating, plagiarism, or fabrications of any type,"


Whereas: There is currently no language that stipulates what the consequences of the violation of these Sections would entail,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 69TH SGA CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MTSU THAT:

Section 1: Upon passing two times in the Senate, this bill will go before the entire student body immediately in the form of referenda via PipelineMT, in a date set by the Election Commissioner and the Election Commission of the Student Government Association.

Section 2: Upon passage of referenda, this bill will go into effect immediately, thus amending the constitution of the Student Government Association to state the above.
