Whereas: Article V, Section 2:F of the Constitution states that a Senator may not have more than two consecutive or more than three, total, with fault found as grounds for impeachment.



Section 1: Senator Sikes shall be impeached and stripped of the title of Senator and all responsibilities, privileges and affiliations thereof.


Section 2: Upon favorable passage, this will go into effect immediately.
