

SGA Bill 4-16-S

A Bill to Amend the SGA Constitution to Send All Notes and Legislation to the University Archives.

Whereas: Middle Tennessee State University university archives are located in the Albert Gore Research Center in Andrew L. Todd Hall.

Whereas: The Research Center houses the historic and official documents and records relating to MTSU, including publications like the university's newspaper. It also houses any collections or items of importance to Middle Tennessee State University, and the community surrounding it.

Whereas: The Albert Gore Research Center has asked for more student organizations to present their history to the center. This includes things like notes from meetings, scrapbooks, etc.

Whereas: Currently, there is no Student Government Association notes or legislation in the archives center. It is vitally important for the university archives to have a record of notes and legislations that the Student Government Association has done.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 78th CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: The SGA constitution will be amended to add a paragraph 3 to Article IV, Section 4, Subsection C. It will read as follows: "Responsibility to transfer all notes and legislation passed for the academic year to the Albert Gore Research Center at the end of the President's term."

Section 2: All past and current legislation and notes available will be sent to the Albert Gore Research Center before the last day of classes in the semester.

Section 3: This bill will go into effect upon favorable passage by the Senate and a student referendum.
