Effective Summer 2021	Change to curriculum of existing major (including concentrations), minor, or certificate	Amend the Environmental Science upper-division form to indicate that the mentor approved electives are "major-supporting" and that "at least 8 hours must be at 3000-4000 level".	10
NFS - 4275 - Applied Nutrition Across the Lifespan Effective Spring 2021	New course	Focuses on the physiologic changes and nutritional needs across the lifespan including components of both standard nutrition and treatment of nutrition-related conditions. Offered spring only. Prerequisite: NFS 2220 and NFS 4270 with B (3.0) or higher; junior status	13

Nutrition and Food Science, Dietetics Effective Summer 2021	Change to curriculum of existing major (including concentrations), minor, or certificate	<p>NFS 4275, which will be a 4-credit hour course will meet the needs of addressing the knowledge requirement of lifecycle nutrition per education standards for the accredited dietetics program, while also providing the course material via experiential learning and using it to introduce students to basic concepts of medical nutrition therapy.</p> <p>NFS 4400, a 2-credit hour course will provide the students with a basic research methods course to meet the accreditation standards in this knowledge requirement area.</p> <p>The 6 hours necessary to add these courses will be obtained by eliminating NFS 4210 Nutrition in Aging and NFS 4250 Maternal Child Nutrition.</p>	14
