

Outcome of Goals

Goal 1

Recruit, enroll, and retain highly qualified diverse applicants.

Metrics & Benchmarks

- **Applicant demographic and academic data** (meeting/exceeding academic requirements & 30% of students meeting program mission aligned attributes)
 - C24:** 100% met at least 1 mission-aligned attribute; 63% met two or more.
 - C25:** 80% met at least 1 mission-aligned attribute; 50% met two or more.
 - C26:** 93.3% met at least 1 mission-aligned attribute; 66.7% met two or more.
 - **Overall Graduation Rate** (meets or exceeds the national average as reported by PAEA for both on-time and delayed graduates)
 - C24:** 93.3% ultimately graduated, compared to 95.4% (94.1% on time and 1.3% short-term delayed) reported by PAEA in Program Report 36.

Goal 2

Promote an environment that encourages a life-long commitment to community service.

Metrics & Benchmarks

- Number of service-learning sites per cohort (benchmark: 10 or more different sites per cohort; 20 or more is a strength)
C24: 14 sites. C25: 16 sites. C26: 13 sites. C27: 12 sites.
- Student intent to continue service-learning after it is no longer required (benchmark: 50% or more; 80% or more is a strength)
C24: 72.4%. C25: 71.4%. C26: 65.4%. C27: 69.2%.
- Faculty/staff involvement (100% either with program and/or personal commitments)
C24–C27: 100% of faculty and staff had community service/volunteerism participation during the cohorts' time with the program.

Goal 3

Prepare graduates to practice in areas of high need and increase access to care to diverse populations.

Metrics & Benchmarks

- **Clinical experiences in rural, underserved, and public health areas** (100% of students will have clinical opportunity in at least one of these areas)

C24 & C25: 100% of students had at least one clinical experience in a rural, underserved, or public health area.

Goal 4

Provide quality medical education that prepares graduates to gain the knowledge, skills, and competencies required to practice as an entry-level Physician Assistant.

Metrics & Benchmarks

- **PANCE pass-rates** (100% pass rate within one year of graduation)
 - C24:** 96.7% of students who have taken the PANCE have passed by the 1-year mark.
 - Note:** *This information will be updated for C25 at the one-year mark.*
- **Summative Evaluation** (100% pass rate, with no students delayed from graduation due to summative skills not achieved)
 - C24 & C25:** 100% of students passed the Summative Evaluation.
