SAMPLE Program of Study for Summer 2026 Entry with Two-year Plan to Completion

Summer 26

- **BLAW 6510** – *Intro to the Law & the U.S. Legal System* (online S5B term 7/6/26 – 8/7/26) **1 credit**
- **RIM 6760** – *Legal Ethics* (In-person @ NSL 6:30 pm with end time TBD, Mondays S6b term 6/29/26 – 8/6/26) **3 credits**
- **Attend (required) NSL 1 ½ day New Student Orientation** held @ NSL on **7/21 – 7/22/2026**. Times TBD (anticipated 7/21 from 9 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. and 7/22 from 9 a.m. – noon). NSL full academic year tuition for NSL 1054L and NSL 1064L plus fees will be due.

Fall 26 & Spring 27

- Two academic year-long courses as an NSL student beginning 8/10/26 and ending late April/early May per NSL's academic calendar.
- **NSL 1054L** – *Contracts* (In-person @ NSL Mondays 6:30- 8:10 pm) **4 transfer credits****
- **NSL 1064L** – *Legal Skills and Values I* (In-person @ NSL Mondays 8:20-10 pm) **4 transfer credits****

Summer 27

- **BLAW 6520** - *Current Legal Topics in Corporate Governance, Risk Management & Fraud* (synchronous online) **3 credits**
- **CYBM 6300** – *Management of Security Operations* (online) **3 credits**

Fall 27

- **Elective** (e.g **BLAW 6530** – *Survey of Selected Business Law Topics* -online or **MGMT 6680** – *Seminar in Negotiation* - online) **3 credits**
- **ACTG 6200** – *International Anti-Money Laundering: Regulation and Compliance* online or in person) **3 credits**

Spring 28

- **Elective** (e.g. **MGMT 6750** - *Business Ethics* - online) **3 credits**
- **BLAW 6590** – *Professional Project* (Choose topic of your interest with approval of Program Director. Synchronous online) **3 credits**

MTSU Course: MTSU tuition and fees apply.

NSL Course: NSL tuition and fees apply. NSL 1054L and NSL 1064L are each 3 credit hour courses per NSL's

policy but will translate to 4 credit hours for MTSU. NSL tuition for each course will be charged based on 3 credit hours times NSL's then-current tuition rate. Currently, NSL gives students the option to pay tuition in full at registration, or in 10 monthly installments each year, with fees due in full at registration.

****TRANSFER CREDITS:** NSL credit hour calculations differ from MTSU calculations. Each 3-hour NSL course transfers as a 4-credit hour passing grade if the NSL course grade is equal to or above the NSL standard to remain in good academic standing according to NSL policy. *You must request and submit your NSL transcript to the College of Graduate Studies at MTSU at the end of the academic year to receive transfer credits.*
